JOB TITLE: POW WOW Security

The United Indians of All Tribes Foundation (UIATF) is a non-profit organization working to provide vital social, cultural, and educational services to Seattle's American Indian/Alaska Native community.

United Indians of All Tribes Foundation will commemorate two historic milestones at its Seafair Indian Days Pow Wow, to be held July 16-18, 2010 at the Daybreak Star Indian Cultural Center in Seattle. This year marks both the 40th anniversary of the takeover at Ft. Lawton by Native activists that led to the founding of the organization, and the 25th anniversary of the annual pow wow itself.

The three-day cultural celebration featuring contest dancing and drumming, Native crafts and traditional foods, and other intertribal exhibitions is one of the largest Native American pow wows in the Pacific Northwest.

JOB SUMMARY:

This Security position will ensure the safety of all persons employed, volunteers and visitors on the POW WOW grounds, parking areas including the Daybreak Star Cultural Center. The Security Staff will create a secure, welcoming environment for all people attending this historic weekend event. Shifts will be eight hours long and will generally be working in teams of two.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Ensure that all areas are secure during weekend event, including gate areas, parking areas, camp areas, vendor areas, dance and drumming areas, and inside the Daybreak Star Cultural Center.

Make certain that no damage is done out of malice to POW WOW grounds, or inside the Daybreak Star Cultural Center.

Assist with setting up tables, chairs, bleachers, vendor equipment etc.

Lift and Haul supplies, equipment and garbage.

Ensure that entire **event is drug and alcohol free**, report incidences to Seattle police and Security Manager, in some circumstances possibly escorting those under influence off the premises.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be 18 years or older.

One year security experience preferred.

Some prior work experience demonstrating the ability to be entrusted with the protection of the people and property at events.

Must be able to assess situations, make judgments and taken immediate action when dealing with dangerous situations.

Must be responsible, take direction and work independently.

Must be able to pass criminal background investigation.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND OTHER WORK CHARACTERISTICS

- Must be able to walk stand for long periods of time
- Must be able to lift fifty pounds
- Must have cell phone for shift calls
